

# What is StarSkate Development?

StarSkate development is a program offered by Connaught SC serving those skaters between the ages of 8-13 years old. The StarSkate development program is designed for skaters who show enthusiasm, potential and an eagerness to pursue figure skating at a recreational level. Entry to this program is by invitation through the CanSkate program or through an audition by our coaches, Ask your coach or email to us if you're interested.

Group lessons include:

- A full 45 minutes of professional coaching.
- Badges and certificates are awarded upon achievement of various levels within the program.

Connaught SC offers 4 sessions of StarSkate Development per year: Fall, Winter, Spring and Summer.

## How to Register

- 1. Entry to this program is by invitation only** through the CanSkate Program, so ask your coach if you're interested.
- 2. Register Online.**— We accept online registrations. Please follow the directions on the other side of this brochure. When you register online you will receive a confirmation of registration. All skaters must register as Skate Canada members (2016/2017 season). The **\$36** Skate Canada fee is payable once per skater per skating year (Sep 2016-Aug 2017)
- 3. Payment:** Full Payment is due upon registration. We accept VISA and MasterCard via our online registration system.
- 4. Late Entry:** Prorating for late entry is available from the 2nd class onwards. Please contact the club email for assistance.
- 5. Skates and Clothing:** Leather figure skates are required (for more information on skates see FAQ page on website) . Girls are expected to wear a skating dress or skirt, or form fitting clothes. Hair must be tied back or in a bun. Boys are expected to wear form fitting clothes.
- 6. Class Location:** All classes are located at Richmond Ice Centre, Richmond, B.C. Please check the notice board and website for any schedule changes.
- 7. Cancellation & Refund Policy:** No refunds after the first class. A written request for cancellation for medical reasons accompanied by a doctor's note will be considered. See website for full policy.
